AND JPG PLANNING EFFORTS. COORDINATES WITH CENTCOM TO PLAN FOR THE INCREASE OR DECREASE OF U.S. FORCES WITHIN THEATER. COORDINATES WITH CSTC-A TO MAINTAIN VISIBILITY OVER OPERATIONALLY SIGNIFICANT TITLE 22 CONTRACTS AND FUNDING. COORDINATES WITH CENTCOM AND ARCENT TO ASSIST SUBORDINATE COMMANDS IN THE EXECUTION OF REQUESTS FOR SUPPORT. ASSISTS THE CJTF-101 NATIONAL SUPPORT ELEMENT (NSE) MISSION, AS REQUIRED, BY KEEPING THE COMMANDER INFORMED OVER CHALLENGES THAT MAY REQUIRE HIS INVOLVEMENT. PROVIDES WEEKLY UPDATES TO THE J3 TO INCLUDE IN THE COMUSFOR-A WEEKLY UPDATE BOOK. ALSO COORDINATES WITH CSTC-A TO MONITOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF LOGISTIC/MAINTENANCE SYSTEMS AND UNITS WITHIN THE AFGHAN NATIONAL ARMY AND AFGHAN NATIONAL POLICE TO INCLUDE UNIT FORCE STRUCTURE/ORGANIZATION, TRAINING PROGRAMS, EQUIPMENT AUTHORIZATION, SUPPLY/MAINTENANCE PROCEDURES, AND PROPERTY ACCOUNTABILITY SYSTEM. AS REQUIRED, REVIEWS OPERATIONS ORDERS, CONCEPT OF LOGISTICS SUPPORT, AND LOGISTICS ANNEXES ACROSS AGENCIES AND WITH MULTINATIONAL FORCES."
