1. YOU MUST MAKE THE PRESCRIPTION ACTIVATION CALL

Once a **NEW PRESCRIPTION** or **RENEWAL** is placed by your provider, **YOU MUST CALL THE PHARMACY TO ACTIVATE THE PRESCRIPTION PROCESS** at **098-971-9355**, **option 7**, **Option 2**

2. YOU DON'T HAVE TO WAIT AROUND

You do not have to wait in the drive thru while we process your order. Your order will remain on the shelf for up to 10 days.

3. PHARMACY WILL TEXT YOU WHEN YOUR ORDER IS READY

Processing times are normally monger than 60 minutes during peak hours.

The pharmacy will send a text message, when your order is ready for pick-up.

If you do not receive a text message within 90 minutes of your Prescription Activation Call, please call back to check on the status of your order.

4. IF YOU USE THE AUTOMATED REFILL LINE 098-971-7999, YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE A TEXT

If you called the Automated Refill Line at 646-7999, you will not receive a text message, your refill will be ready in 2 business days.














GIANT EAST AFRICAN LAND SNAIL

Invasive species to Okinawa that can grow over 7 inches in length!

TRANSMITS PARASITES THAT CAUSE MENINGITIS

Don't touch the snails!

If your toddler eats one, take to the ER.



LEPTOSPIROSIS

Bacterial infection that may cause severe bleeding, liver failure, kidney failure, meningitis, acute respiratory distress, and possibly death.

Found in *fresh water* and soil, most cases in Okinawa come from waterfalls and streams on the north end of the island.

Avoid recreational activities involving fresh water,
Infection occurs through open wounds and contacts
with mucosal membranes (eyes, nose, mouth).
See your doctor for prophylactic antibiotics if the water
cannot be avoided or if you fall in.

It affects humans and pets, get your dogs vaccinated


