Substance abuse degrades morale, cohesion, performance, and readiness, and it prevents our ability to fight and win in combat.

The Marine Corps policy on use of illegal or illicit drugs is simple - **ZERO TOLERANCE**

Substance abuse is not limited to the use of illegal drugs. Prescription medications, over-the-counter drugs, and alcohol abuse are just as dangerous when used in ways not consistent with their intended purpose. The effects of various drugs and alcohol impair a person's capacity to think clearly, assess risk appropriately, and act responsibly.

If you are concerned about someone you believe to have a substance abuse problem, obtain help through your medical provider, professional addiction counselor or Substance Abuse Control Officer (SACO), or chain of command.
